



No Fee – Caterer's Endorsement to a Manufacturer's Licence to Sell

AGCO Board Resolution

WHEREAS subsection 3(1) of the *Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario Act, 2019* (AGCOA) provides, among other things, that the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) shall be responsible for the administration of the alcohol, cannabis, gaming and racing statutes and regulations made under them;

AND WHEREAS clause 13(1)(a) of the AGCOA provides the Board, subject to the approval of the Minister, with the authority to establish fees or other charges for the purposes of the AGCOA and for the administration of any of the alcohol, cannabis, gaming and horse racing statutes (or any regulations made under them);

AND WHEREAS subsection 1(2) of the AGCOA sets out that the *Liquor Licence and Control Act, 2019* (LLCA) is included as one of the alcohol, cannabis, gaming and horse racing statutes referred to in the AGCOA;

AND WHEREAS subsection 3(2) of the LLCA provides that a holder of a licence issued under the LLCA may request a prescribed endorsement on their licence;

AND WHEREAS certain amendments to Ontario Regulation 746/21 are proposed, which would allow a person who holds a manufacturer's licence to sell with a by-the-glass endorsement to be eligible for a caterer's endorsement;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Board establishes under clause 13(1)(a) of the AGCOA, subject to the approval of the Minister, that there is no fee for the administration of the new caterer's endorsement that may be granted to those who hold a manufacturer's licence to sell with a by-the-glass endorsement.

Paragraph 1 is effective on the date that the amendments to Ontario Regulation 746/21 come into force, subject to approval of the Minister.
