Did you know?

You must now go online to the iAGCO portal to conduct all of your AGCO transactions. This includes:

- ✓ renewing your licence
- adding another licence
- ✓ changing/updating your information on file with the AGCO
- ✓ reactivating a licence that has expired within the last 5 years
- ✓ paying a fine
- transferring a trainer
- ✓ adding/removing a horse from the EIPH program (after July 1)

HOW DO I START USING iAGCO?

To manage your licence(s) on the iAGCO portal, you'll first need a one-time access code to create an iAGCO account that links to your information already on file. After that, you can log in anytime to conduct your AGCO transactions.
